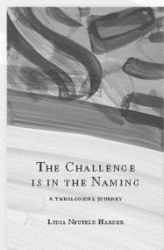

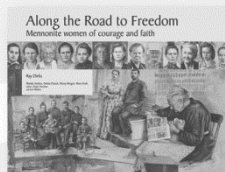

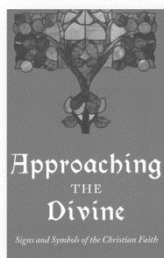
***The Challenge is in the Naming: A Theological Journey***
