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Cover: The cover image, a modern quilt entitled “Jubilo,” combines the juxtaposition of past and present, tradition and modernity. Taken as a symbol of the diversity of Mennonites in Canada since the 1970s, the image of a traditional quilt is turned on its head here, as the quilted pattern in “Jubilo” draws upon diverse shapes and colours to form an asymmetrical whole that explodes across the surface without a central element binding all its pieces together. The quilt explores the theme of celebration, a suitable symbol for marking the fiftieth anniversary of the Mennonite Historical Society of Canada.
